There are over 300 species of birds - herons, ibises, small cormorants, fishing eagles, sea eagles, seagulls, pelicans, Siberian singing swans, and cranes; Mongolian golden eagles, Chinese cormorants, Mandarin ducks and a lot of European songbirds.

There are over 40 species of freshwater fish. The area is under protection.

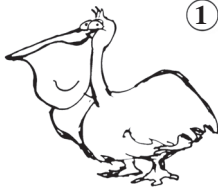

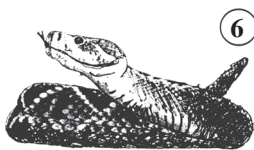

This bird arrives at the Danube Delta from China. It is between 43-51cm long. The male is the most beautiful of all ducks. Its bill is red and it has white legs with yellow feet. The female is less colourful. It eats seeds, aquatic plants, insects, snails, fish, frogs and small snakes

This bird has got the longest beak of any bird in the world. It is large and heavy. It is about 180 cm long. It has got short legs, a long neck and webbed feet. It can swim very well. It eats fish. It can catch them with its huge beak.

This animal has got a long body and short legs. It's smaller than an otter. It is 40-45 cm long. Its tail is about 13-14 cm. It weighs 500-800 grams. It has got webbed feet. It can swim very well. It eats fish, frogs, snails, eggs and baby water birds.

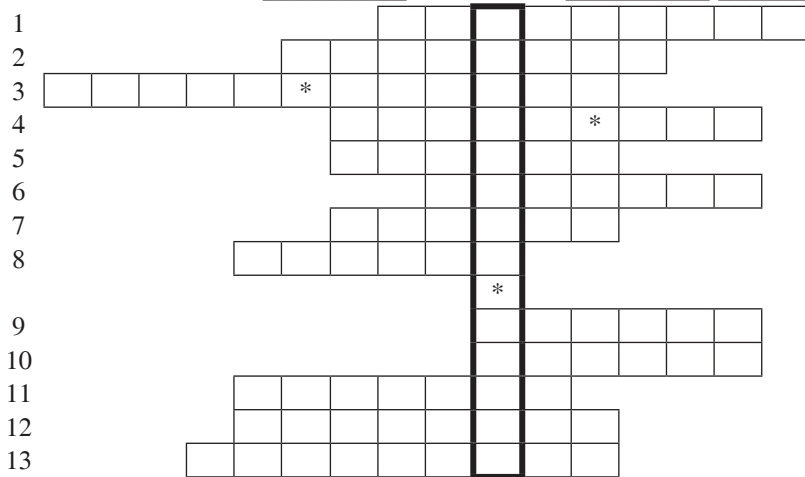
This animal is a reptile. It is very dangerous. It has got a long body. It is 30 cm - 2 m long and often has zigzag or diamond patterns. It hasn't got any legs.

This animal has got a long grey and brown body and short legs. It is 40-65 cm long and weighs about five kilos. It lives in and near water. It can swim very well. It eats fish, frogs, baby rabbits and baby ducks.

This bird is about 90 cm with very long legs and a long thin neck. It has got a long yellow beak. It can stand and wait in the reedbeds for hours. It can fly up on trees. It lives by lakes and rivers. It builds its nest on trees and bushes.
